

NAME THAT CHRISTMAS CAROL PICTURE GAME


Directions:

- Print out page two, the illustrations. Print out one page for every person who will play.
- 2. Players should write the name of the Christmas Carol they think the illustration is portraying somewhere in the box or around it.
- 3. Print ONE copy of the answers, page three. Only one person should hold the answer sheet, and answers should not be shared until everyone has finished filling out their guesses.
- 4. The person holding the answers then reads them out one by one, after letting players shout out what they think is correct. Whoever has the most actual correct answers can win a small prize or just enjoy the kudos for winning. If you choose to award a prize, it could be a candy bar, or any small gift.
